I	am a Project Payback participant, and in order to
•	estitution service hours, I must obey the following
rules:	

- Community restitution service hours are separate from, and in addition to, the Court-ordered community service I am required to complete and submit to my probation officer.
- I will complete hours at an <u>approved site</u>. I understand any non-profit community organization, church, hospital, school, retirement/nursing home, & city/county/state government site is acceptable. <u>If I have a question about a site, I will call</u> <u>Project Payback to get approval before starting my hours.</u>
- I will NOT perform my community restitution service hours for a relative or at a relative's place of employment.
- I will make my own contact with the service agency and set up a work schedule to have the assigned hours completed within the time allowed.
- I will be on time for my community restitution service work and I will stay at the service agency until I have completed the scheduled hours.
- My Logs will be filled out correctly:
 - ✓ I will use the provided Project Payback log, not the Department of Juvenile Justice log.
 - ✓ I will be sure to list the community service site and the telephone number.
 - ✓ I will make sure the a) date of service, b) time began and ended, c) total number of hours completed, and d) activity completed is filled out and signed by the person who supervised that day's activity, not my parent/guardian.
- I will make sure the service agency records my hours so that Project Payback can verify my work.
- I understand my log will be verified before being paid out. Project Payback will not accept the hours if the hours are unable to be verified.
- I will turn in my log during the same month that the work is completed; otherwise it may not be accepted.
- If I have an upcoming court date, I must submit my log to PPB by no later than 4pm on the day before my scheduled court date.
- For every hour of community restitution service I successfully complete at an approved site, Project Payback will pay \$8.00/hour toward my court ordered restitution.
- I must turn in my community restitution service log to Project Payback, **not** to my Juvenile Probation Officer.
- If I falsely report my community restitution service hours, Project Payback will set me for a hearing and bring my case to the attention of the Judge.
